Lottery for Youth Hunt

Youth hunters and trappers invited to lottery drawing!

Huron, OH, July 25-Erie MetroParks has scheduled a lottery on Saturday, August 6th to give young hunters and trappers a chance to hunt with permission at the East Sandusky Bay MetroPark - Joseph Steinen Wildlife Area located on Cleveland Road, Huron.

The lottery will take place at the West Huron Youth Clubhouse, 4511 Cleveland Rd West, Huron, OH. Doors open at 8:30am, and interested youth hunters or a representative must attend a mandatory informational meeting beginning at 9:00 am. Please note:

- No late arrivals will be admitted.
- The drawing will follow the meeting.
- A valid Ohio youth hunting license must be presented to register for the lottery.

Permits will be drawn in the following order:

- 18 upland game (all legal species except white-tailed deer and waterfowl) permits
- 7 deer archery permits
- 8 trapping permits

Afterwards stay for A Day Afield- co-sponsored by the West Huron youth Club, Erie MetroParks and ODNR- Division of Wildlife. A Day Afield is scheduled as follows:

- 10am-2pm-Calling Demonstrations, Dog Retrieval Demonstrations provided by Zink Calls from Port Clinton
- 2-3pm-Safety demonstrations and tours of the hunting areas provided by Club Members
- Lunch and beverages are provided.
