

Birmingham School MetroPark Natural Resource Management Plan

Erie MetroParks mission is to conserve natural resources while connecting the community with nature through education and exploration.

Birmingham, which is owned and managed by Erie MetroParks, is located on SR 113, just east of SR 60 in the Village of Birmingham (*see attachment property map*). From SR 2, take SR 60 (Savannah-Vermilion Rd) exit and turn south. Turn east on SR 113 (Edison Highway). After about 1/4 mile the park is on your left. The MetroPark was donated to your Erie MetroParks by Florence Township in 1995. The property had originally been the site of the Birmingham School, whose original archway still stands. The 3.3 acres of primarily green space gives visitors a basketball court, a gazebo picnic site and playground for the kids.

Management efforts mostly include maintaining the grass, parking lot, and facilities.
