

Erie MetroParks Ohio Wildlife Youth Art Contest Rules

Please read the following rules for contest entry:

- Must be K-12 Erie County student in a public, private, or home school education group.
- Students do not need a school sponsorship to enter. Parents or teachers may help students enter the contest.
- Must depict a native plant or animal subject found in Ohio in their natural habitat: threatened or endangered species are encouraged, not required.
- Any art medium can be used! Must be on paper no smaller than 4x6 inches, and not to exceed 18x24 inches in size.
- Entry must be less than 1/4 inch thick.
- Entry form must be completed and taped or attached to the back of the artwork- please no names on front of entry.
- One entry per student.
- Entries will not be mailed back to you. You may collect your artwork following the Art Contest Awards Ceremony at Osborn MetroPark on April 23 at 4:00 p.m., or the following week (until 4/29/22) at Frost Center during regular business hours.
